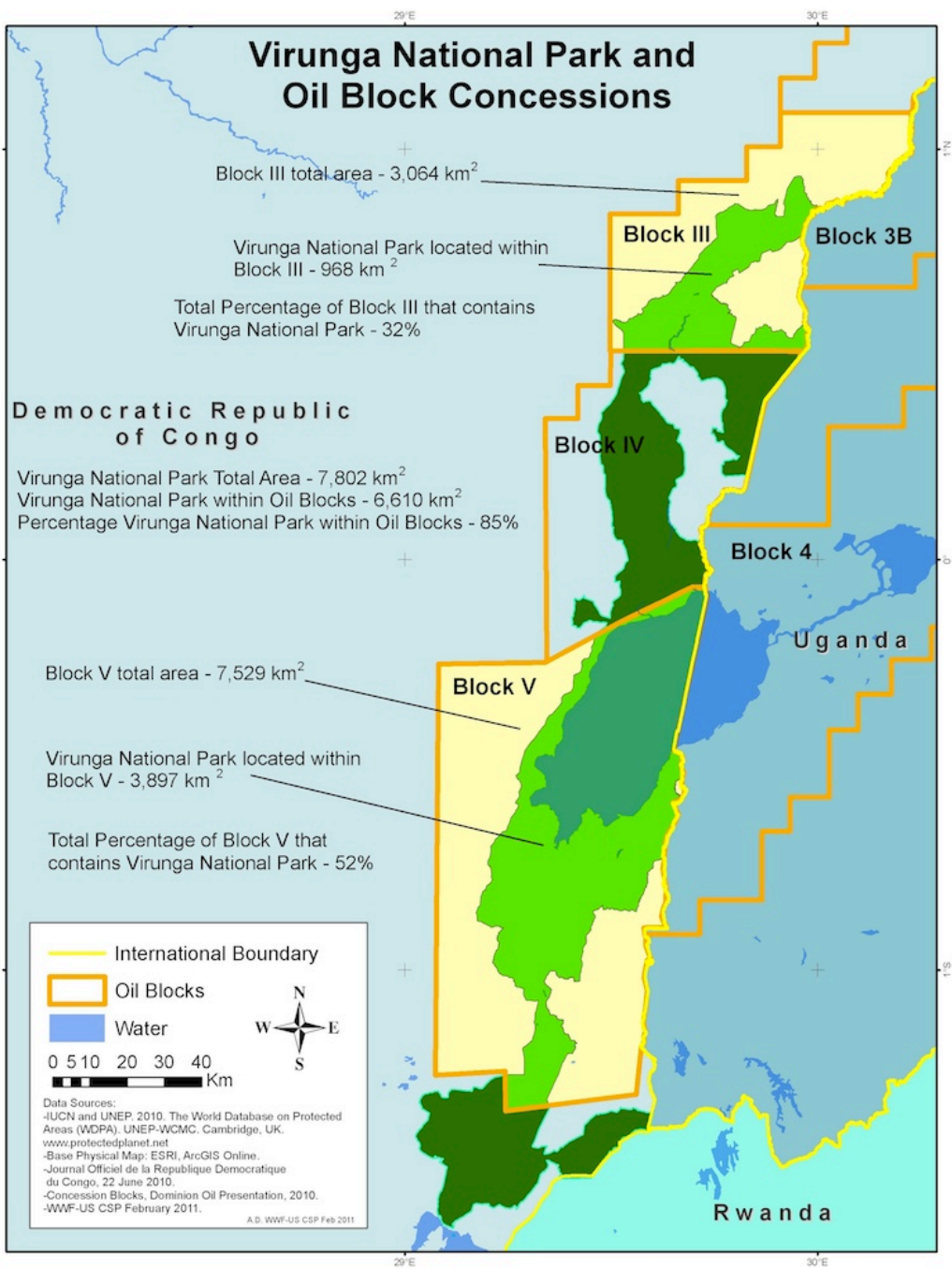

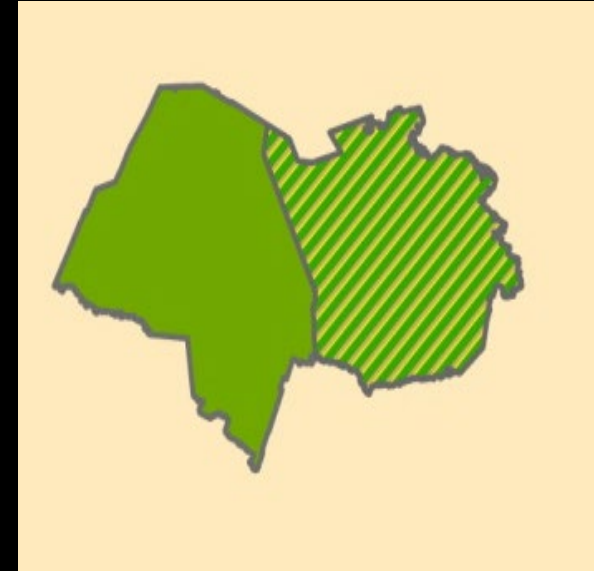

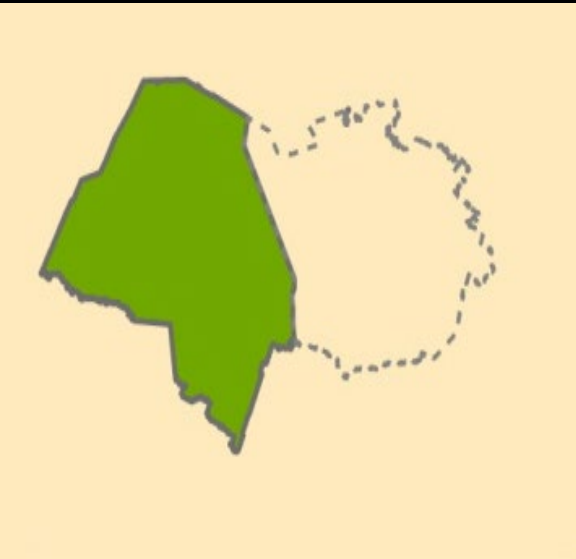

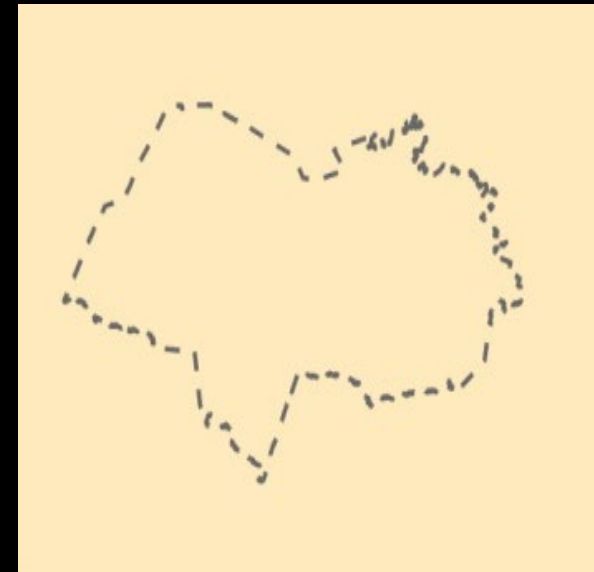

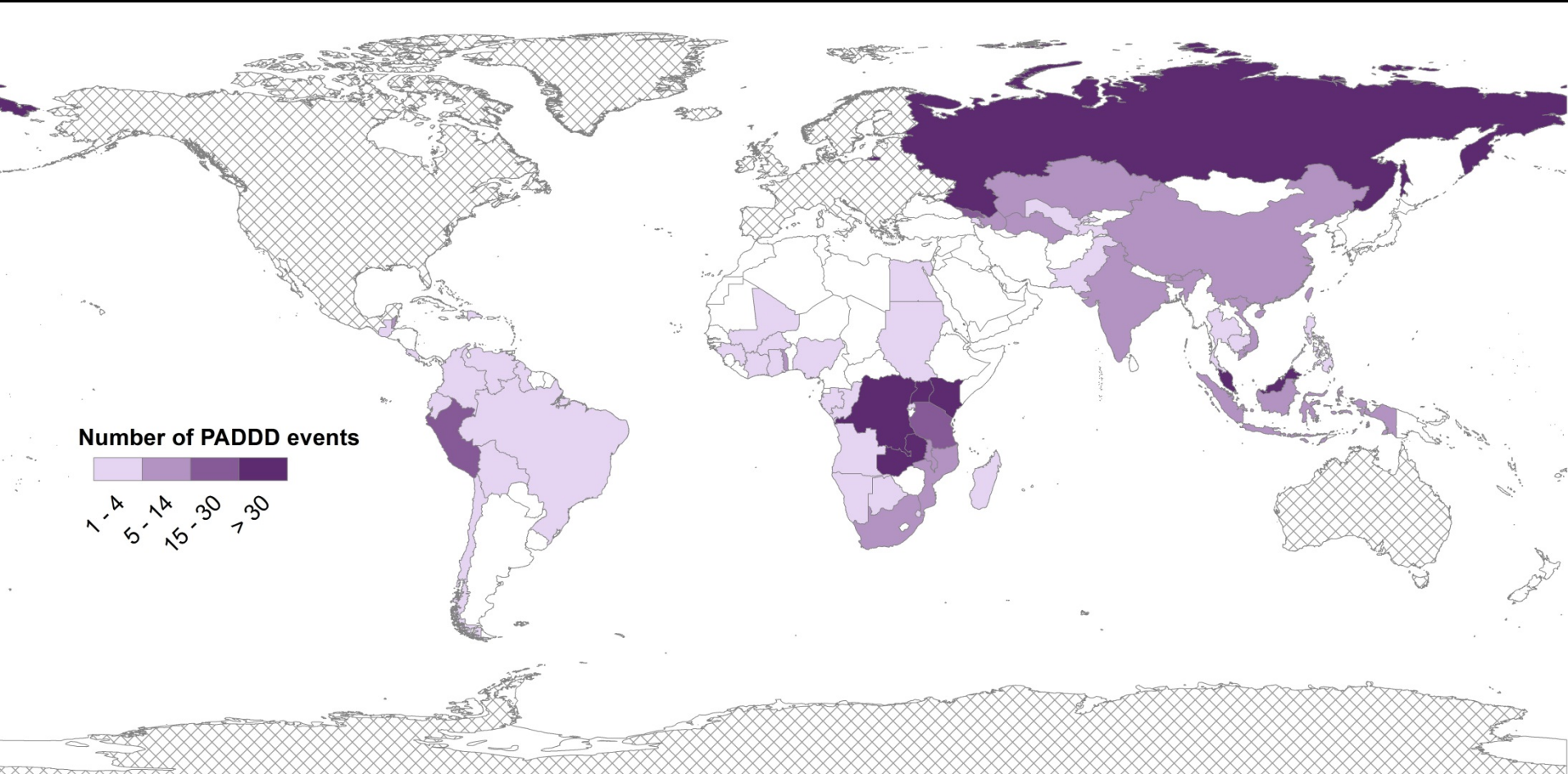

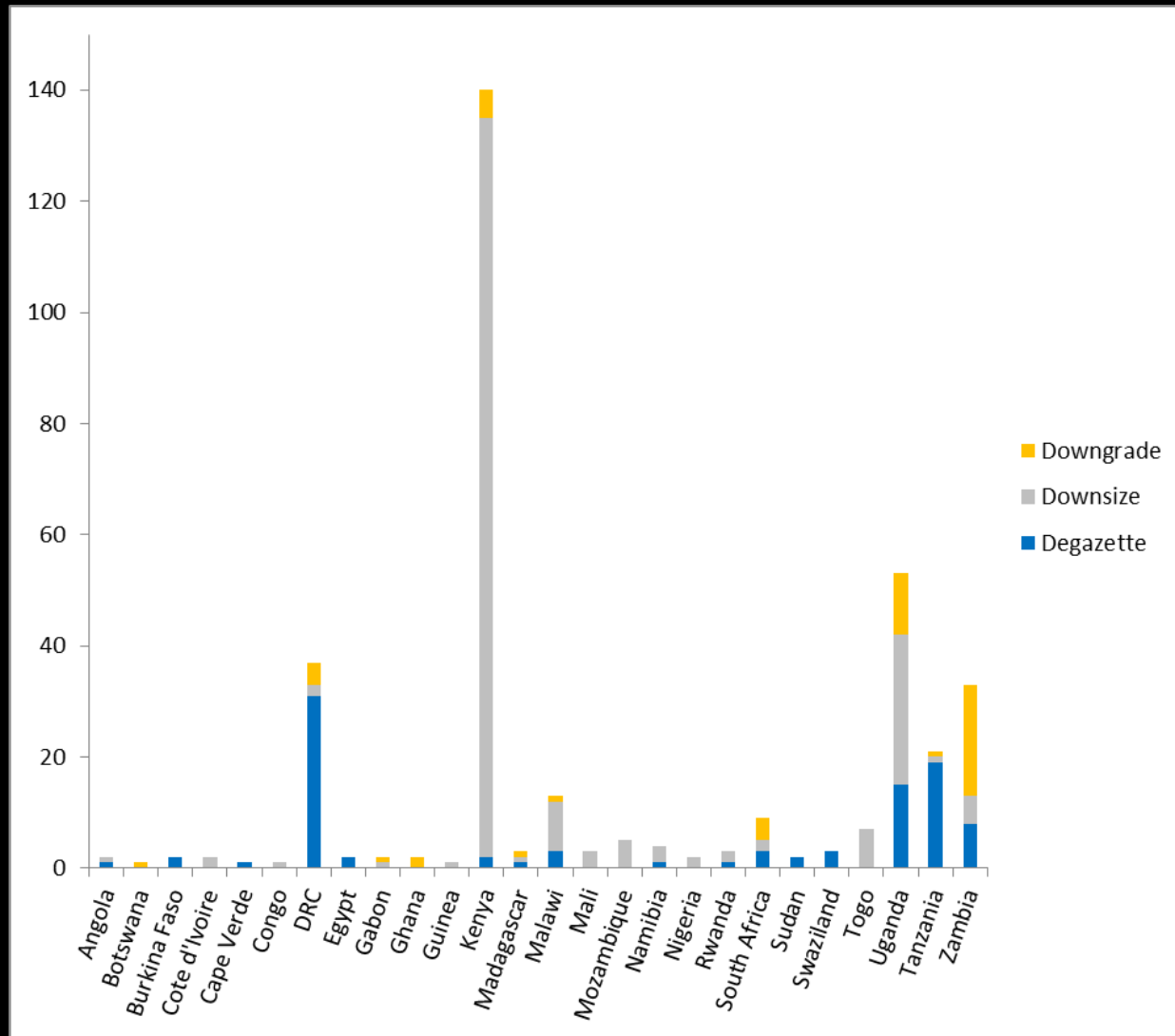

PADDD events, 1900-2012



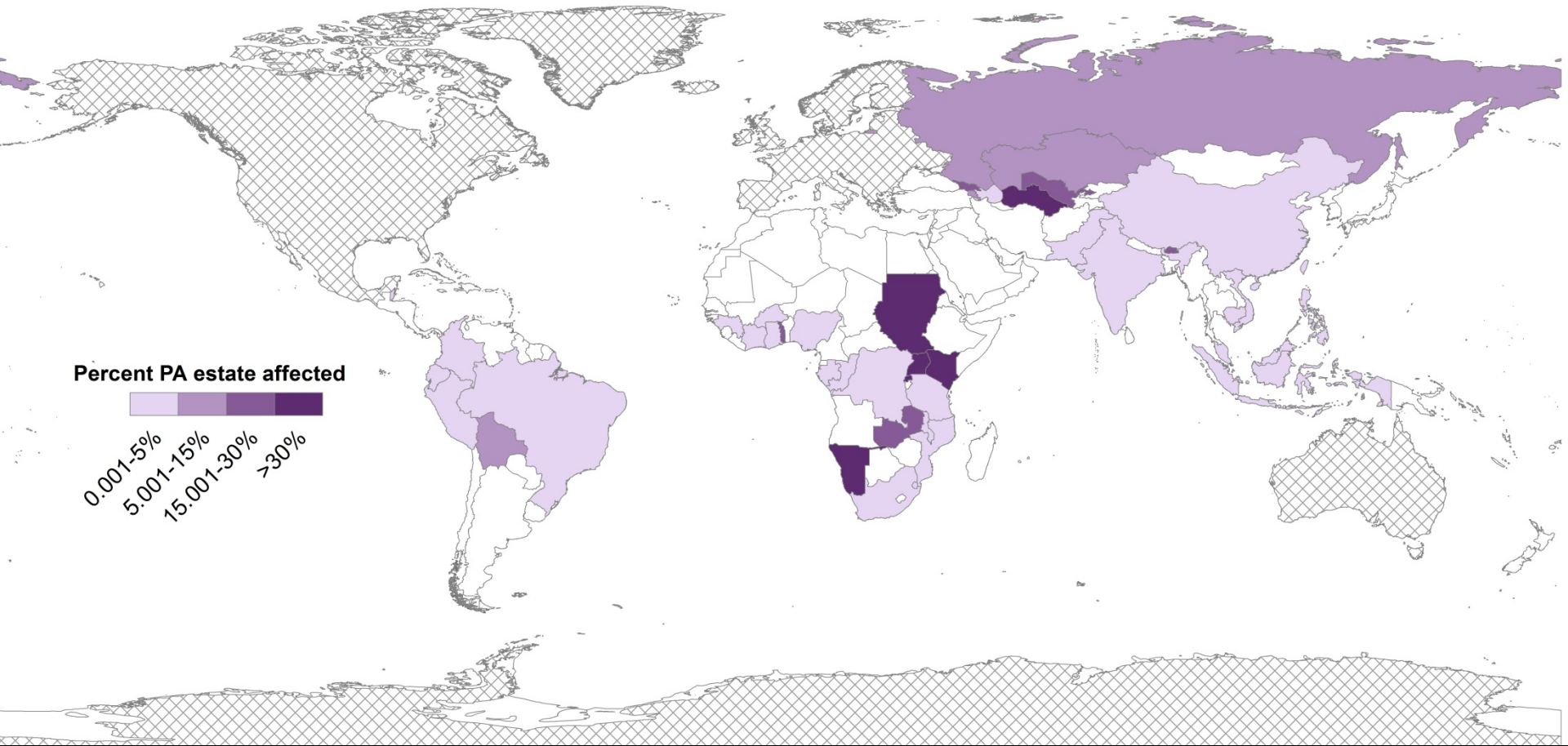

African PADD, 1900-2012



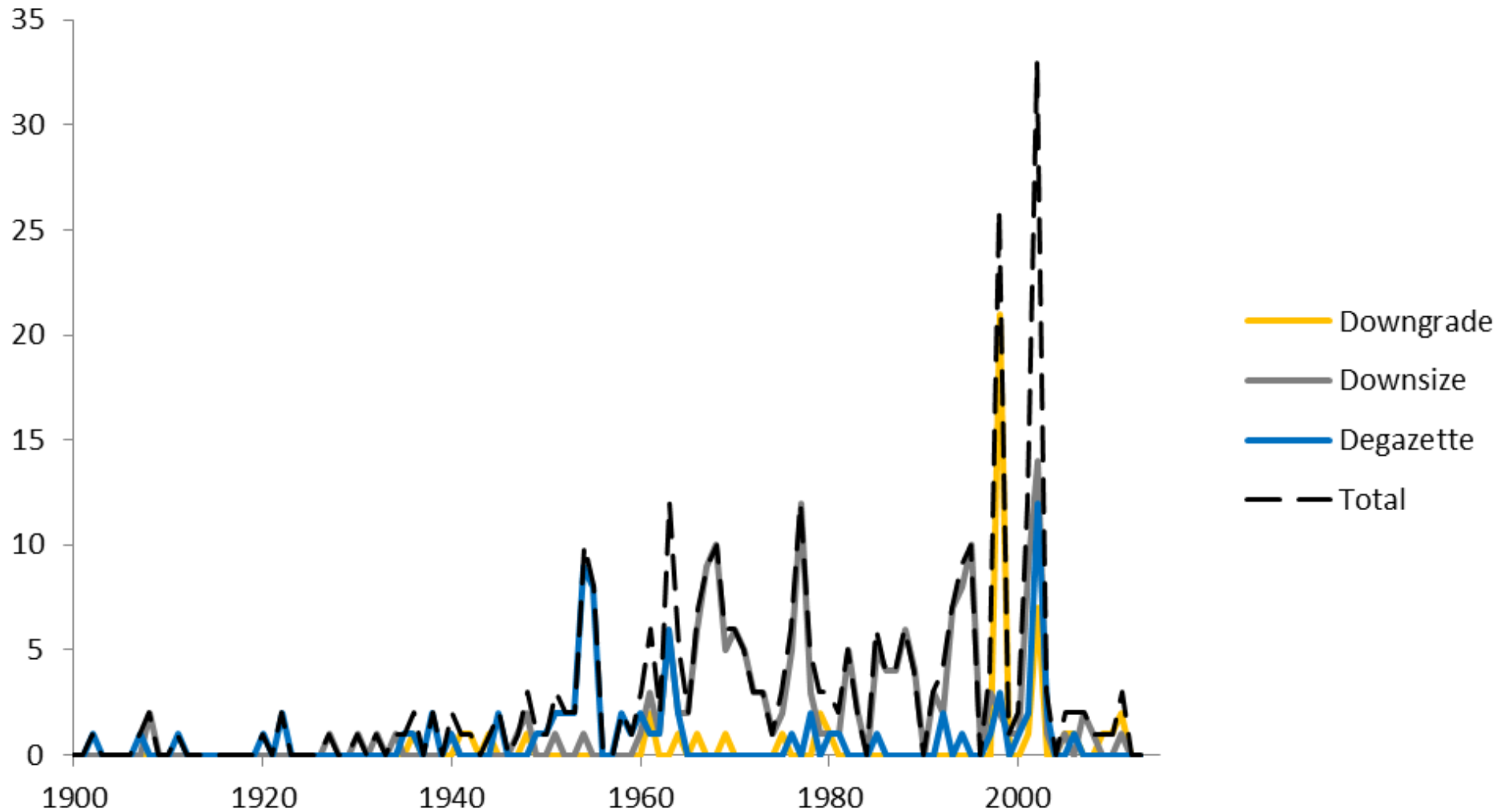

PADDDed PA estate, 1900-2012



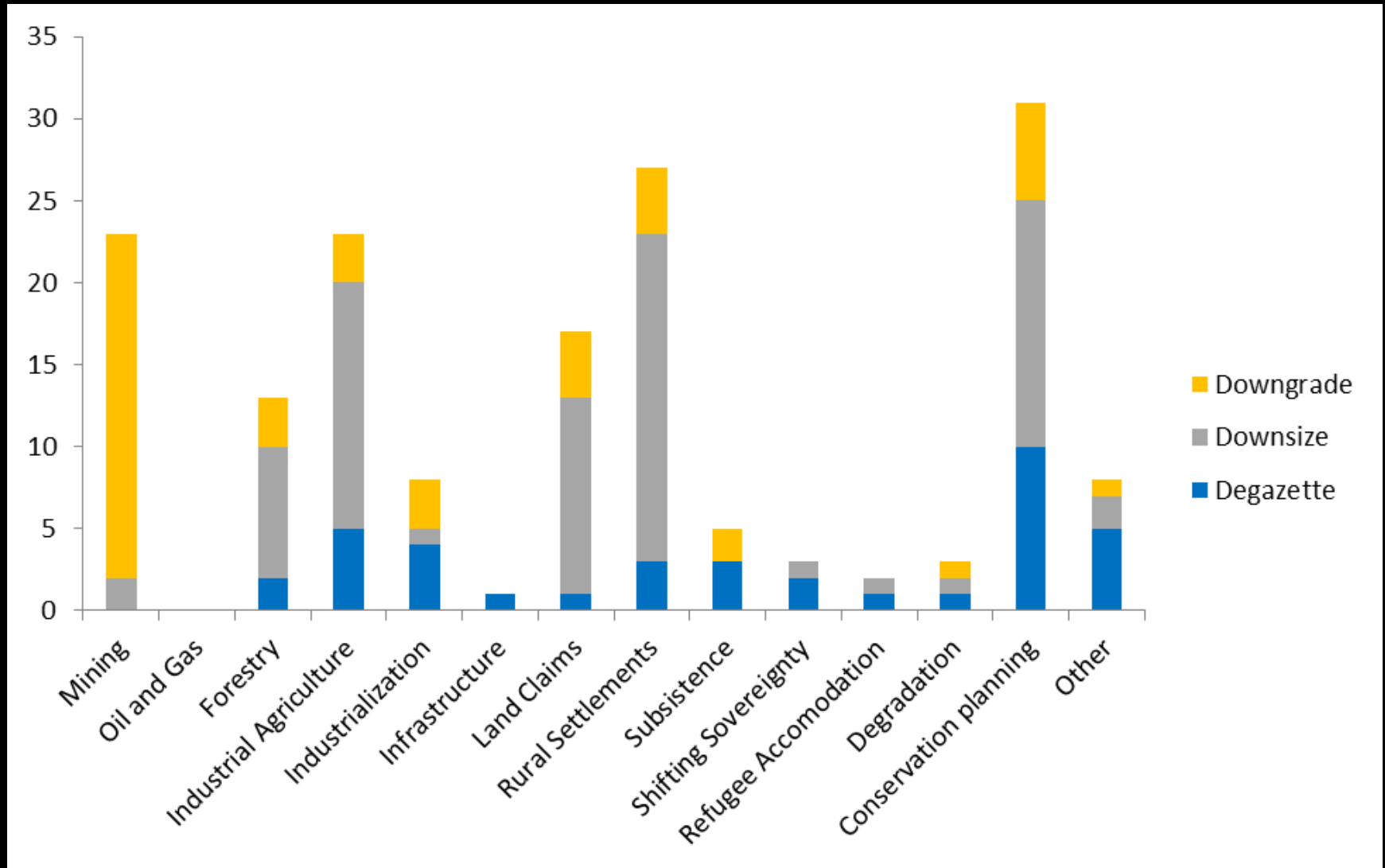

African PADD events, 1900-2012



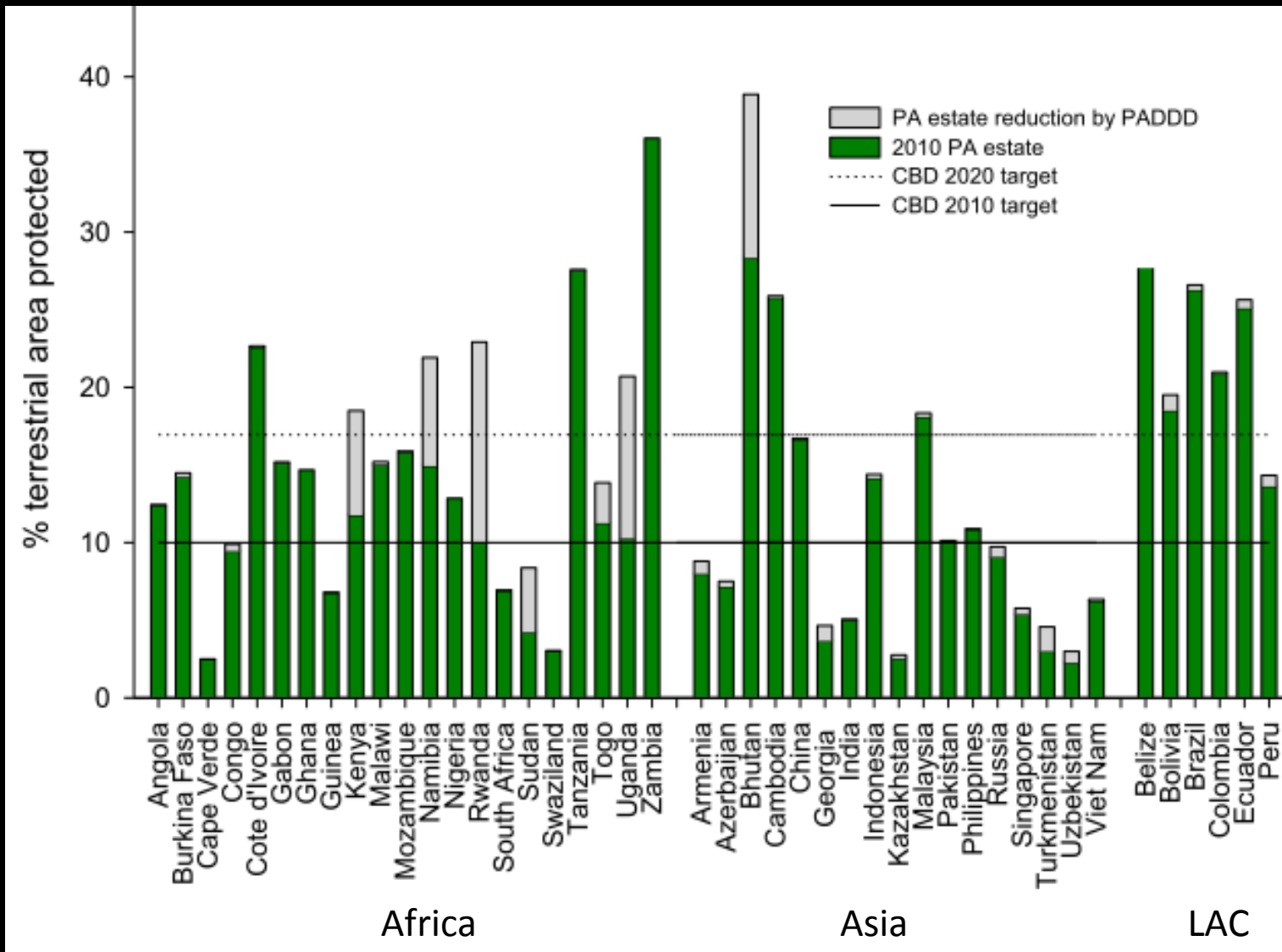

Proximate causes, African PADD



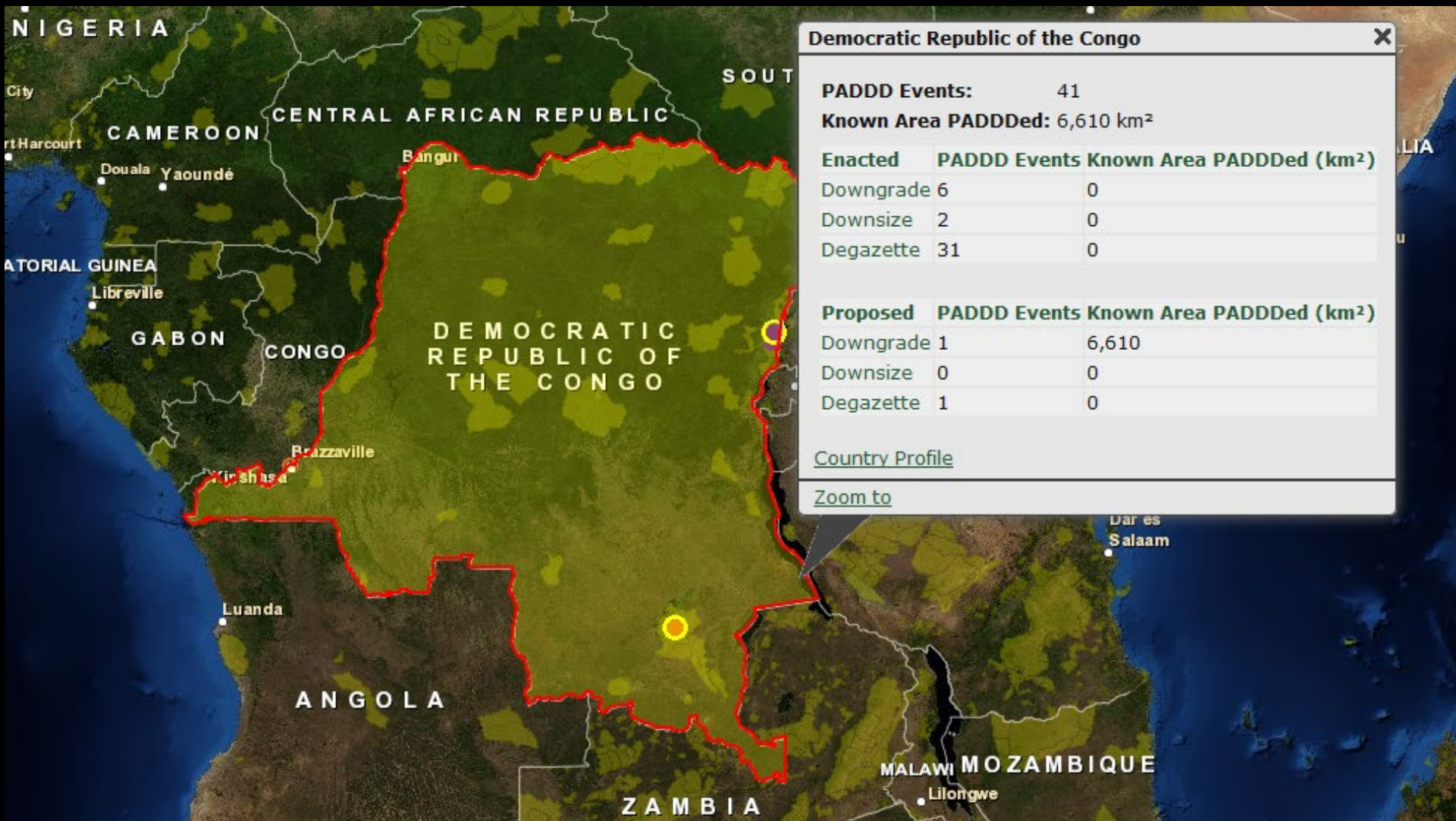

Implications for CBD 2020



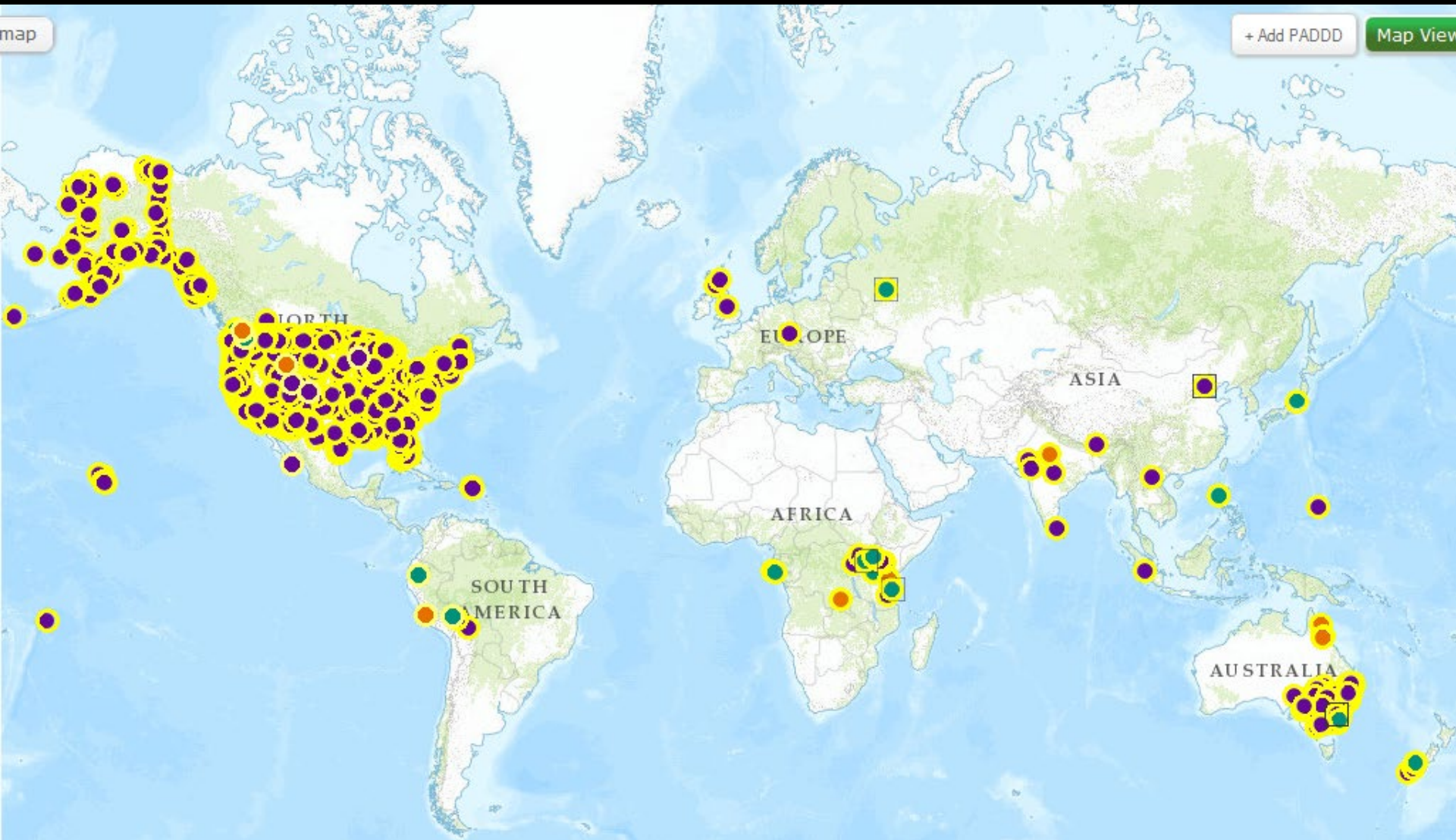

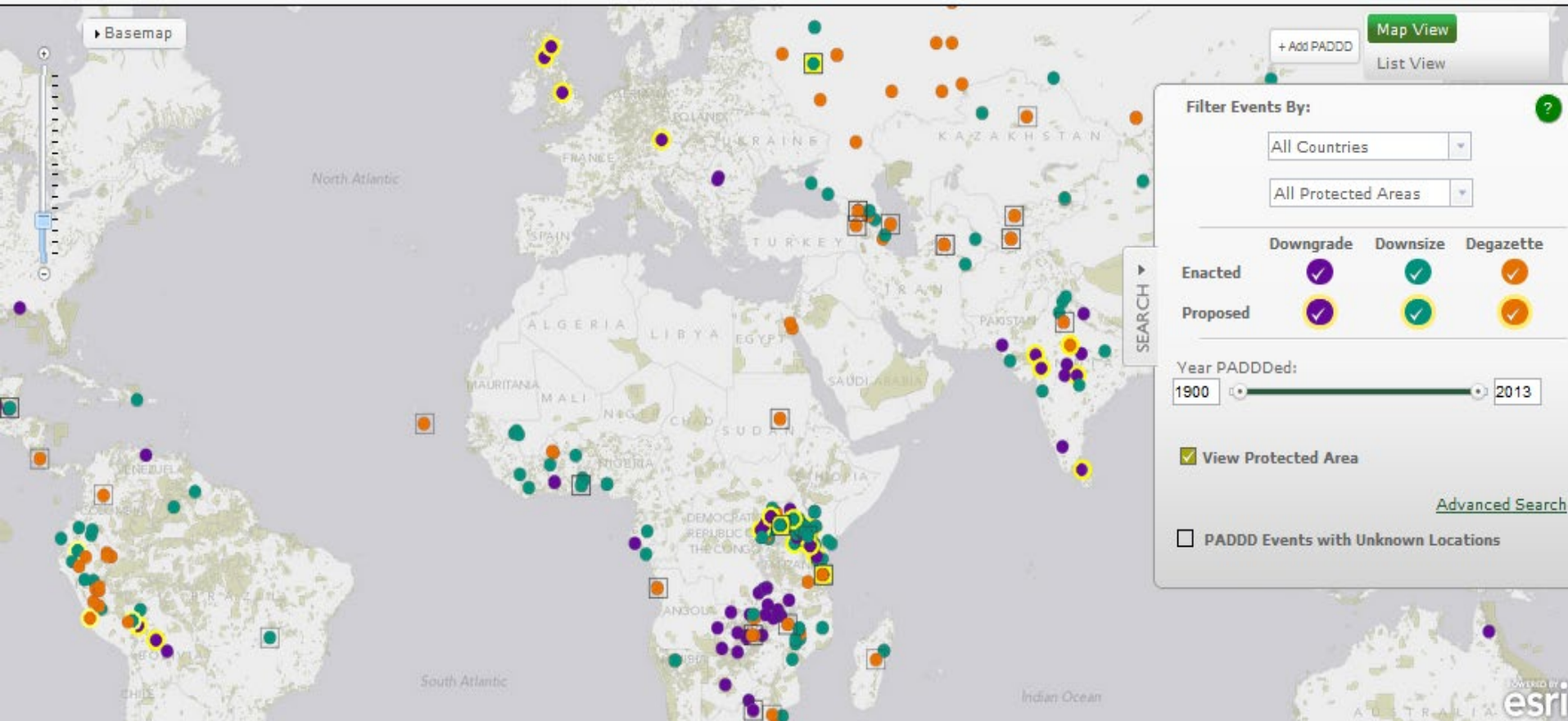
